The rate of sickness absence hit its highest figure in over a decade in 2021. An increase of over 22% from the previous year is not a small increase.

Sickness or injury accounted for nearly 150 million working days lost in 2021. This equates to an average of 4.6 days lost per worker, though according to a survey, 49% of small businesses owners said their employees take off over 5 days per year.

employees or less where we can provide guidance on general health and safety, answer any specific queries you may have, suggest practical solutions, and explain the legal requirements that come with being an employer.


